Thiago joined the Los Patojos school when he was 5 years old. He thrived in the program; he is an energetic child who loves to run and play. Unfortunately, in March 2022 he was hit by a car near his home. Amongst other injuries his leg was severely broken. The local public hospital in Jocotenango was unable to repair the fractures. His mother had no funds to pay for private surgery. Thais of the Wellness Team at our school contacted a trauma doctor in the capital who agreed to do the necessary surgery for free, as well as supervising the recovery process.
